Footnotes

SILVER SIERRA unhurried early found stride bidding three deep on the far turn, forged clear into upper stretch drawing out in the three path. PURE POLISHED prompted the pace racing four and five wide to the far turn, bore out badly there coming nine wide into upper stretch, remained responsive on the far outside holding as a clear second best. OSCAR DE LA THORN rated back early would struggle under prompting on the far turn, gave a modest response in upper stretch improving position racing four and five wide. RAMBLIN SALLY raced evenly firing to threaten on the far turn, overpowered into upper stretch would drop off in the four path. TBIRDS SUNSHINE was hustled out engaging the pace while saving ground, extended through the far turn would wear out near the rail in upper stretch. CHELSEYS FAN was never involved. ELLE SOCIETY dropped back early laboring throughout. CLUNY BREEZE stalked the pace for half a mile then wilted on the far turn .
