SANDIPAT tracked the pace edging closer on the turn, wrested the lead at mid track upper stretch drawing out under a drive. RAVELLA pressed early then backed away on the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch regrouped coming on to salvage place. QUEEN OF FORTUNE saved ground rallying into upper stretch vying late along the rail. DUCHESS OF SPAIN raced evenly coming five wide in upper stretch, angled to the six path showed belated interest. CAME A STORM bumped by SANDIPAT rider lost his irons at the start, regained quickly racing wide to upper stretch finishing evenly in the seven path. GOT NO ANSWERS breaking sharply pressured the pace through the turn into upper stretch, extending along the rail was empty late. SWEET JILL was always outrun. WILQUEEN chased early then pressed up on the turn, gave way in two path mid stretch. SHOSHONE GUIDE showed little. SOPHIA'S CHATTER dropped back early.
