KAIN'S VOW pressed MS. RED HAWK soon after the start, drew even entering the stretch traveling in the three path, slowly edged away in deep stretch, won clear at the wire under a drive. MS. RED HAWK broke sharply gaining control, headed by KAIN'S VOW turning for home, battled to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly proving a game second best. IMA GIVEN settled mid pack racing a little off the rail, swung out five wide upper stretch, finished willingly besting rest. BOOK VALUE lacked speed, saved ground throughout, hit best stride upper stretch, finished with interest improving placing. PATENT PENDING raced evenly in the second flight, swung out six wide upper stretch, lacked needed punch. CAROL'S GIFT hustled leaving the gate, stalked top pair to the quarter pole, gave way upper stretch. RISING BAROMETER lacked speed, raced wide throughout, failed to factor.
