DOLL DREAMS laid close up stalking through the turn, bid three deep in upper stretch going clear in the four path. IM A DIXIE DIVA pressured the early pace then chased EDEN STAR on the turn, extending between horses in the two path down the lane stayed on gamely. EDEN STAR pressured the pace shaking clear on the turn, hooked in the three path upper stretch would drift toward the rail weakening late. SHARP BOURBON slow early gained on the turn then held position down the lane finishing evenly in the three path. GOLD SADDLE hustled on the outside raced five wide on the turn weakening at mid track in upper stretch. BRIDAL TRAIN slow early swung out seven wide in upper stretch offering little. CATCH MY EYE was always a step slow. CHAOTIC CAT chased early then retreated on the turn. ARRICIA PRINCESS flashed early speed then gave way on the turn.
