HEART OF A KING stalked the pace through turn inheriting the lead when MR. REGENT broke down near the quarter pole, went clear in upper stretch holding firm under a drive in the three path. SIR ROMEO went evenly early then gained on the turn, bid from the four path in upper stretch responding to save place. NEON NIGHTS chased the pace through the turn extending into upper stretch, would wear down late in the three path. DARCY BOY raced mid pack through the turn gaining a bit near the quarter pole, dropped off the leaders in upper stretch holding position with even action near mid track. BRAHMS LULLABY slow early played no factor. CAPTAIN BOB JO JR. off slowly was never involved. SELDAN was always outrun. DOOMER showed little. FORPETEYSSAKE pressed and chased on the turn then gave way along the inside upper stretch. MR. REGENT broke down near the quarter pole.
