SOFIASHUTCHBUSTER lagged far off the pace to mid turn, gained momentum near the quarter pole, quickly closed in entering the stretch while splitting foes, drove clear inside the furlong marker and widened late under strong handling. HI TECH TOY led in the early going, dropped off leaving the far turn, came again entering the stretch and held the lead between calls, dueled with SOFIASHUTCHBUSTER to deep stretch, proved no match but held place position in a game effort. COVER MY SIX raced up close from the start, bid four wide vying for the lead top of the stretch, soon flattened out mid stretch. SHADY ED rated early while racing mid track to the half, rallied four wide to a menacing position at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and flattened out in the drive. BIG JIMMY J. pressed for the lead entering the backside, took over at the half, headed near the quarter pole, was all done giving way mid stretch, used up. RUN THE COLORS lacked speed and raced towards the rail throughout, roused to no avail, never threatened. LEVA MAE well placed running mid pack to the half, started to fade leaving the quarter pole, no factor in the stretch.
