HANA BAND stalked along the inside through the far turn, angled out to upper stretch surging clear at mid track. CAN'T SPELL tracked the pace pressing to wrest a short lead on the far turn, extended four wide down the lane would ceded grudgingly to outside pressure. BOBBIE'S DEVIL went evenly circled out six wide to upper stretch, gained position with steady response. HIGHLAND CAT slow early gave a mild rally on the far turn then weakened the final eighth. KISS A COYOTE dropped back, saved ground to upper stretch, proved no menace. RED SANDY stayed back through the far turn, proved no factor finishing with some interest. THE ONE TO CHASE gave a prompted middle move, pressed on the far turn then weakened down the lane. JEFFREY'S CAT hustled to the top, moved the pace through the backside then gave way on the far turn. ROSTEBARAN was always outrun.
