POT OF GOLD a step slow early gave a quick four wide move near the five sixteenths pole drawing out in upper stretch finishing full of run. CHILLIN VILLAIN broke alertly setting the early pace, engaged on the turn was overpowered into upper stretch hanging on late in the three path to salvage place. ROUNDUP JADE slow early came five wide in upper stretch, angled to the six slot responded with a late surge. AUDITORIUM veered in bumping at the break, was hurried in pursuit through the turn, weakened in the four path upper stretch. WYO BANDITO hustled off the pace gave a mild move on the turn then leveled off near mid track upper stretch. TRACK RECORD played no factor circling six wide in upper stretch. BUDDHA CAN DANCE bumped at the break would stay back throughout. TRUTH ENDURES chased the pace through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. ATHLEAGUE ROS remained sluggish throughout. THE REAL STORY labored throughout.
