GUSKA'S GOLD slow early angled inside to upper stretch, surged near the rail, got up gamely. COUNTRY IN pressed through the turn taking a slim lead in the two path upper stretch, battled to wire just missing. WILD INQUIRY chased through the turn, extended in the four path down the lane bid willingly to wire. WAY TO OZ off slowly came six wide upper stretch, bid evenly on the outside late. TETON STAR pressed early then chased on turn, finished evenly in the four path. MR. BOURBON STREET slow early came five wide upper stretch, lacked late surge. HYRULE hustled out pressed a short lead to upper stretch, wore down there along the inside. SNOWBOARD RIDGE dropped off on the turn. LIVINGSTON'S GHOST pressed early then gave way on the turn.
