**Footnotes**

DON'T SHOOT measured on pace shook clear in upper stretch maintaining the edge while hand ridden. POWER OF TITUS well rated gave a prompted four wide move to upper stretch, giving all abreast DON'T SHOOT proved second best. LUCKY DRAGON laid close up stalking the pace through the far turn, angled in a bit at the head of the stretch going evenly the final eighth to hold the others well safe. NITA RIDGE stalked the pace giving a prompted middle move using all to stay with DON'T SHOOT through the far turn, rebuffed by the leader would fade at mid track in upper stretch. BROKE BY NOON unhurried early was circled out to mid track in upper stretch offering little there. BRITELUCK was never involved finishing up in the three path. SHANES GOLD stalked the pace through the far turn then folded at mid track in upper stretch. PRINCE OF PAULIE was always outrun.
