HOLLY WINK settled far off the early pace, narrowed the gap on weakening duelers entering the stretch, angled three wide splitting foes in deep stretch, cleared late and prevailed under steady handling. DUBAI MISTAKE raced evenly in the second flight, rallied four wide upper stretch, vied abreast foes in deep stretch, was outgamed by the winner missing in a good try. NOONTIME BADGE chased a pair of loose duelers around the turn saving ground, angled out taking aim top of the lane, loomed from mid stretch, needed more late picking up the show position. MY FRIEND WES broke in intimidating BIG PUNCH at the start, quickly rushed up to challenge for the lead, battled with MEDIA GROUPIE to mid stretch, gave way late finishing spent. MEDIA GROUPIE sent hard from the gate, dueled running along the rail to mid stretch, gave way inside the eighth pole, used up. REAL INCOME was off slowly racing wide down the backside, trailed to mid stretch, never factored. SAINT GEORGE lacked speed racing mid track throughout, never menaced. BIG PUNCH broke in and was taken up briefly, hustled up to chase, gave way top of the stretch.
