SHE'S THE PRIZE well placed from the start, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, drove clear mid stretch, increased margin under steady pressure. IMA MITEY MOUSE tracked the pace racing between foes mid turn, angled to the rail mid stretch, surged late securing second place in a willing manner. SPRING A LATCH made a slight hop as the gate opened, quickly recovered, rushed up to take control traveling along the inside, moved to the two path entering the stretch, could not go with the winner form the furlong marker, faded late missing second place. MARCHING BAND broke alertly but was out sprinted by SPRING A LATCH for the lead, stalked that rival throughout, threatened in upper stretch, tired late being outfinished for a minor award. SOFIA AND MIA raced evenly in the second flight, angled six wide mid stretch under a drive, failed to menace. KISS THIS LOVE moved to the rail shortly after the start, failed to factor. G. I. JODY was outrun in the early going racing wide, rushed a five wide move mid turn to reach contention, loomed at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and flattened out mid stretch. BLACK ARROW quickly retreated, trailed mid turn, finished well beaten.
