Footnotes

HANDSOME BRUNO unhurried from the gate, angled to the rail and saved ground throughout, made a steady advance leaving the far turn, collared HOPEFUL BANDIT leaving the quarter pole, drove clear in upper stretch, won drawing off being ridden out for a convincing victory. FOR YOU REppo lacked speed and trailed in the early stages, bid between foes mid turn, angled to the four path upper stretch, chased the winner in the lane but never menaced finishing a willing second best. HOPEFUL BANDIT set a rated pace running towards the inside, moved off the rail leaving the quarter pole, headed by the winner entering the stretch, dueled briefly in upper stretch, weakened late while holding onto third place. FAST PROMISES dropped off to trail going to the half, gained on the bend racing between foes, angled to the rail top of the lane, leveled off needing more late. JAZZY GIANT raced five wide into the first turn, stalked to the half traveling three to four wide, loomed at the quarter pole, began to tire entering the stretch, no late threat. RAMBLIN MIKE lacked speed racing towards the rear and well off to the far turn, mounted a mild bid mid turn, chased briefly entering the stretch, flattened out in the drive. MERLIN BAY was forwardly placed stalking to the far turn, began to fade midway on the second turn. CASTLE QUARTER tracked down the backstretch, rushed a four wide move at the half, chased around the turn, gave way leaving the quarter pole. HOPPING HOLLY lacked speed, racing wide down the backstretch, dropped off midway on the second turn, no factor.
