ON TOUR saved ground advancing to contention on the turn, fanned out four wide in upper stretch drawing clear under a drive. SPYGLASS sent hard worked the pace nursing a short lead through the turn, hooked from the outside in upper stretch proved no match saving place in the two path. EXCLUSIVE ELUSIVE stalked the pace looming through the turn, extending at mid track in upper stretch gave an even finish. TRICK O MAN slow early stayed back through the turn, came five wide in upper stretch improving past tired ones. SHOW ME THE CASH slow early played no factor. EL TAJIN was never involved. ELUSIVE SCHEMES hustled out pressured the pace through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. EXCHANGE NOTE dropped off on the turn. MILWAUKEE CHIEF was eased on the turn.
