BOLDER COURSE broke alertly and quickly cleared, set all the pace under a good rating, drew off under urging entering the stretch, won comfortably under steady handling to the wire. HIGHLAND MIST raced up close from the start, was angled out mid turn, chased winner into the lane, never menaced but held place in a willing effort. GINAS WONDER settled in the second flight, rallied to split foes at the quarter pole, angled a bit wider in upper stretch, closed willingly picking up a minor award. TEVEZ was off a step slow, angled to the rail and saved ground throughout, made a bold move entering the stretch, leveled off inside the furlong marker needing more. COWBOY COLONEL settled in mid pack, was angled wider in upper stretch under a drive, mildly bid but was no real threat. TRI SEVENTYFIVE pressed the winner briefly, chased form the quarter pole, angled wider in upper stretch, weakened late. CELTIC CHIEF raced evenly at mid track, swung eight wide top of the lane, failed to threaten. PRIMULA lacked speed and raced wide around the turn, never factored. LARK'S TUNE was well placed racing at mid track, hard ridden from mid turn, lacked response and faded in upper stretch. MALA MALA SON was quickly outrun, never involved.
