HIT KING reserved early running towards the inside, gained momentum mid turn, angled out four wide top of the lane, lightly brushed with WHISPERS PROMISE in upper stretch, was under strong left handed stick in deep stretch, surged in time gaining a hard earned victory. ALL SNUFFED UP stalked the leader from the start, roused turning for home, edged clear in deep stretch under an all out drive, was out nodded by the winner just missing in a very good effort. GRAN TIRO set a well rated pace running a little off the rail, headed in upper stretch, dug in under pressure, was outfinished late by top pair while saving third place in a hard effort. DREWUP settled in the second flight, saved ground throughout, rallied mid stretch holding a menacing position with a furlong to go, needed a bit more late besting rest. FALSE DILEMMA lacked speed racing off the rail, swung out six wide upper stretch, mildly improved but never threatened. WHISPERS PROMISE stalked early traveling in the three path, chased from the quarter pole, lightly bumped with HIT KING in upper stretch, weakened from mid stretch. LIGHTNINGFASTMAN lacked speed and trailed throughout, roused to no avail, no factor. BELLAMY FLYER was off slowly and trailed in the opening strides, rushed into the first turn, tracked running four to five wide down the backside, gave way in upper stretch.
