Footnotes

DIXIE'S ANGEL broke alertly and was sent to the top, raced a little off the inside while setting soft fractions, headed by THE LADY WAFFLES entering the stretch, dug in under an all out drive, just held on being fully extended. THE LADY WAFFLES raced up close early, was rated back some for the run down the backside, traveled four wide on the turn, rallied to vie leaving the quarter pole, raced a head off the winner from upper stretch, could not get by coming to the wire, was out noddod in last jumps, very game effort. SPOTTED PEARL unhurried from the start, raced along the rail on the bend, put to a drive at the three eighths pole, was compromised by a slow early pace, finished willingly to gain the show position. GRASSHOPPA tracked the pace under a rating, settled running off the rail, bid four to five wide entering the stretch, leveled off late. MERRY GREY well placed throughout, saved ground to mid turn, angled out top of the lane, came up empty in the drive. SAMMY'S D J rushed a middle move racing between foes going to the half, chased the winner on the turn, began to weaken top of the stretch, no factor in the stretch run.
