Footnotes

SO PROPER tracked the pace through the turn, angled abreast rivals upper stretch surging clear in the three path. VIVENDI'S VERDICT chased and pressured the pace through the turn, extended in the two path upper stretch would cede between horses saving place. LADY LANNIS sent clear pressed on lead through the turn, shaking clear near the rail in upper stretch would falter late. NATURALLY BOLD raced evenly throughout holding the others safe from mid track. HUNDRED ACRE dropped off on the turn finishing evenly in the six path. TOES ON THE CURB chased the pace through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. KEELYANDKOYSPRAYER stumbled badly at the break losing all chance. SWORN OATH was always outrun racing seven wide through the stretch. SUNSET SUMMER labored well back. AVARYL'S PAL folding on the turn was eased sharply in upper stretch.
