Footnotes

COACH SHAW slow early fired leaving the turn wresting the lead from the four path in upper stretch drawing clear late. ITS ON FIRE pressed early shaking clear on the turn, hooked in the two path upper stretch ceded then angled to the three slot holding up for place. DANCEHALL FEVER a step slow through the turn angled to mid track in upper stretch bidding evenly late. TAXICAB raced evenly gaining a bit on the turn, moving at mid track down the stretch lacked a closing surge. LAZY NATHAN raced evenly cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, extending from the rail would level off late. BELIEVE DAT chased through the turn then faded in the three path upper stretch. BUCK CASH was always outrun. LONG RANGE MISSILE pressed then chased through the turn, stopped abruptly near the three sixteenths pole.
