LOOK WHO outrun early, began to respond mid turn, circled out 4 wide looming off of STORMIN JANETROSE in upper stretch, surged steadily under the whip to go clear. TWISTED FEATHER off slowly, trailed the field through the turn, swung out 6 wide in upper stretch, surged belatedly to claim place. STORMIN JANETROSE broke to a quick lead, moved alertly maintaining edge through the turn, dug in for the stretch, became leg weary along the inside giving way late. LILY MARTINI went unhurried early in second flight, prompted to action edging closer on the turn, poised for bid in upper stretch, weakened under the whip. SENORITA ECHO hustled out to pursue STORMIN JANETROSE 4 wide into the turn, loomed a threat coming 5 wide to the lane, weakened the final 1/16 dropping off. IZZIES ROSE sent from the break, moved to STORMIN JANETROSE on the turn, loomed a threat in upper stretch, wilted nearing the wire. BEEDA hopped then ducked inside at the break, played no factor. GRATEFULLY rushed close up, pursued full out on the turn, was spent at the head of the lane.
