**Footnotes**

FALL SEMESTER unhurried from the gate and trailed down the backside, gained ground leaving the far turn, rallied five wide entering the stretch, drew even at the eighth pole, slowly edged away under steady handling. PINEAPPLE JOE moved out to race off the rail entering the backside, rallied four wide to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, dueled racing between foes mid stretch, was outfinished by the winner coming to the payoff, settled for second best in a game effort. FIDDLERS PRIDE pressed the pace soon after the start, put a head in front mid turn, vied in a three way battle from mid stretch, ceded grudgingly in deep stretch, good effort. JULISKA settled towards the rear, was unresponsive to upper stretch, found stride too late, closed strongly nearing the finish line but was no threat. GO GO MOJO hustled early and set a pressured pace vying to the half, dropped off mid turn, was all done in upper stretch. SNOWBOARD RIDGE was well placed early, advanced three wide on the bend, vied for command at the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch, no late factor. HEADLINE raced evenly along the rail, put to a drive at the quarter pole, lacked surge never threatening. GLACKITY GLACK hustled from the gate, raced four wide vying for the lead going into the first turn, gained a slight advantage at the half, started to drop off at the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch finishing spent. SUCCESSFUL AFFAIR raced briefly in mid pack, gave way after a half, stopped entering the stretch and was eased across the finish line.
