MATTY'S GUN pressed a short lead through the turn widening to upper stretch, held firm in the three path. EVAN'S EMERALD slow early came six wide to upper stretch, rallied up for place near mid track. MANHASSET INDIAN was hustled out pressing three deep on the turn, extended through the stretch weakened late. TIN SOLDIER tracked evenly on the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch. FIRE RIDGE sent hard pressed between horses on the turn then gave way in upper stretch. HIS NAME WAS RICO slow early played no factor. BEAUGAR saved ground as no factor. ROCKEM SOCKEM veered in at the break, stayed back after. TIM HAS MONEY hustled off the pace, folded up six wide to upper stretch. IAM DIXIE brushed at the break would labor.
