PREDATOR RIDGE broke alert to the top moving to a clear lead on the turn, hooked between horses mid stretch would dig in gamely from the two path. STORMY PAST chased the pace through the turn coming three deep upper stretch, bore down on PREDATOR RIDGE late to no avail. SUPREMACY angled in near the five eighths pole chasing on the inside through the turn, bid along the rail down the stretch giving all the final eighth. MY BOY ANGIE slow early angled four wide in upper stretch giving an even finish. ALL THE GLORY a step slow while saving ground proved no menace. CHARLES THE HAMMER raced along the inside playing no factor. SURGE PROTECTOR away slowly was always outrun. GOLDEN LINKS offered little. FLYING NIGHTMARE pressed early then gave way on the turn.
