WAR IN DUBAI veered out at the break, pressured early shaking clear on the turn, widened in upper stretch then held driving along the inside. RAP STAR raced evenly through the turn, emerged off a loose WAR IN DUBAI in the two path upper stretch, angled out a bit while closing the gap late. MY CELTIC STAR pressed then chased through the turn, extending in upper stretch came up a bit short in the three path. FASHIONABLY LATE bumped at the break stayed back through the turn, gave a mild rally along the rail down the stretch. FOR SCORPION raced evenly through the turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. MY POWER BULLET was never involved finishing up at mid track. JOLINDA retreated on the turn. THE LADY ISA CHAMP was always outrun. RUN RUN RITA offered little. WILD PACIFIC WAVES brushed at the break was always outrun.
