Footnotes

DOING WITHOUT stalked early pressing up to challenge on the turn, dueled three deep down the lane extending up late in the four path. CULPEPPER CREEK pressured the pace dueling from between horses on the turn, battling through the lane stayed on to the end in the three path. WHY HE'S ENOUGH bumped at the break was hurried to the top working to keep a head in front through the turn, dueling inside of rivals in the two path down the lane would cede grudgingly late. ARCTICAN BREEZE went evenly through the turn angling out six wide in upper stretch, used steady response to best the others. DURANTS AFLEET bumped at the break was outrun through the turn, came three wide in upper stretch proving no menace. STORMS OF YANJI away slowly stayed back through the turn swinging seven wide in upper stretch as no menace. BARBARA'S CHOICE was always outrun. BLACKNGOLDSUPRBOWL gave hard pursuit through the turn then faded at mid track in upper stretch. BULL BACK pressed early then gave way on the turn. MARGINALSAINT pulled up when bleeding in upper stretch.
