TURNPIKE TOMMY stalked close up looming on the far turn, bid clear in the three path upper stretch angling in a bit while holding firm. WILLIE BAGS raced evenly in mid pack to the half, responded on the far turn edging to contention coming five wide in upper stretch, chased TURNPIKE TOMMY the final eighth a willing second best. HAIL TO THE CHIEF sent clear set the pace staying clear through the far turn, overpowered in upper stretch would weaken late in the three path. ONE COOL DUDE (ARG) unhurried early was roused on the far turn saving ground to upper stretch, found no late surge in the two path. BLUE SOLDIER was never involved. SLIVER raced second flight tiring in upper stretch.
