ENCAUSTIC tracked the early pace racing off the inside to the far turn, hooked SEA DUBAI wresting the lead near mid track in upper stretch then drifted out under left hand urging while drawing clear. RESEARCHER was tucked in early, angled out on the backside advancing four wide to threaten on the far turn, looming off ENCAUSTIC at the head of the lane would drift inside holding up for place. CRYPTOLIGHT was well placed sitting close up to the far turn, dropping off the leaders there was angled to mid track for the stretch run giving even action the final eighth. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE raced evenly while staying close to the far turn, hard roused there would extend to bid along the inside in upper stretch, began to waver near the rail dropping off late. JOHN'S BURGER laid close up pressuring the pace to the half mile pole, wavered into the far turn retreating there with no recovery. BIPOLAR EXPRESS stalked through the backside then gave way abruptly on the far turn. SEA DUBAI broke alert making a short lead working that into the far turn, pressured there would fold along the inside in upper stretch. WESLINN failed to respond.
