MAGDACARR a step slow along the inside angled out to upper stretch, fired inside the eighth pole, drove up six wide. MAJOR STRIKE chased early, pressed up to challenge on the turn, dueling through the stretch was out gamed late. ACCORDING TO MIKE chased the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, led along the inside upper stretch, extending late couldn't hold. RAYWICK a step slow early was rushed up on the turn bidding four wide to upper stretch, looming from the eighth pole would hang late. CAN'T SPELL slow early came five wide to upper stretch, bid evenly late needing more. TIM HAS MONEY slow early circled out six wide in upper stretch, proved no factor. ALRIGHT NOW dropped off on the turn, raced seven wide through the stretch. SNACK DADDY broke sharply, set the early pace, hooked on the turn would wear out. THATSALOTTABULL was always outrun.
