Footnotes

MANHASSET INDIAN tracked a heated pace duel, rallied six wide entering the stretch, drew abreast rivals upper stretch, put a head in front at the eighth pole, was all to hold on coming to the wire, just lasted. WINDHAM HILL pressed for the lead shortly after the start, had to briefly steady when in tight going into the far turn, settled and moved a bit wide stalking around the bend, came again to vie between foes in upper stretch, dueled running inside of the winner from the eighth pole, matched strides to the wire, lost the head bob in last jump, hard try. FOREST LIGHT sat patient racing along the rail, rallied entering the stretch, drew even to vie for command at the furlong marker, was out finished in deep stretch, solid effort. FAST FASHION broke sharply, was engaged for the lead form both sides going into the far turn, dueled while between foes to upper stretch, ceded stubbornly late, used up. LORD ELDON trailed early, gained some momentum entering the stretch, angled wide mid stretch, showed late interest but was no real threat. HARVEYS VICTOR rushed hard to press for the early lead, battled gamely to upper stretch, was all done at the eighth pole, used up. JAY'S SUAVE lacked speed, raced in the second flight throughout, failed to respond when asked for more. CAYENNE RED hustled showing brief foot, chased to mid turn, faded mid stretch. GLITTER CANYON lagged throughout, never factored.
