Footnotes

MANOFTEWEST stalked the pace following D'BULLDOG through the turn looming abreast in upper stretch, reeled in the pacesetter outside the sixteenth pole drawing out in the three path. D' BULLDOG breaking sharply would hustle a clear lead through the turn into upper stretch, digging in near the rail was overwhelmed by MANOFTEWEST a sixteenth out holding up for place. I'D MARRY ME bobbling leaving the gate was hurried along from off the pace coming five wide in upper stretch, finished evenly near mid track. JUSTICE EXPRESS slow early varied little through the turn, had a modest response in the four path down the stretch. JOE'S LAD chased the pace through the turn then faded in the two path upper stretch. ASHORE was never involved racing six wide through the stretch. KING THOU ART went evenly through the turn then faded along the rail down the stretch. DESI'S DEMON would bump in close quarters near the seven sixteenths pole. ROGUES HOLLOW was bumped and forced to steady in tight near the seven sixteenths pole.
