Footnotes

HELLIECAT stalked early pressing to put a head in front on the turn, bid clear in upper stretch angling out to the six path under left hand urging holding firm to wire. POLITE LIL SIR chased early then dropped off on the turn, came six wide in upper stretch rallying late abreast rivals to save place. FLYINGPALM broke alertly pressing on lead dueling on the far turn, ceded a clear edge to HELLIECAT in upper stretch weakening late in the two path. THUNDER MINISTER slow early gave a mild rally to upper stretch being bumped by FIRST NITE outside the three sixteenths pole, continued on with even action holding position. MONEYINTHECUVEE went evenly tracking the pace through the turn, came four wide upper stretch weakening under a drive. FIRST NITE pressed the pace through the turn, angled out bumping with THUNDER MINISTER near the three sixteenths pole having little left there. BIG JAY chased early then faded on the turn. CHAPEL RUN folded up on the turn. TEXAS HOLLADAY was eased in upper stretch jogging to the wire.
