**Footnotes**

NATALIE'S CASTLE vied early racing along the rail, was in tight and steadied briefly going into the far turn, came again entering the stretch, battled inside of NICCET from top of the stretch, edged clear mid stretch and held safe under heavy pressure to the wire. NICCET rushed into the turn, vied in a three way battle mid turn, matched strides with the winner to mid stretch, was outgamed late missing in a very hard effort. WINK AT THE BOYS dueled with the top pair running between on the turn, could not keep pace from the eighth pole, held third place in a good try. CONGAREE PRINCESS lacked early foot, angled in upper stretch, split foes mid stretch, hit stride late and finished strongly. DEBS PRETTYGIRL well placed tracking a contested pace, saved ground around the bend, angled out a bit under a drive top of the lane, lacked needed response. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON hustled from the gate but lacked early foot, settled mid pack racing off the rail, swung six wide under a drive upper stretch, failed to menace. SAPPHIRE AVENUE rushed a four wide move to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, soon flattened out in upper stretch, no late threat. HEART OF ROSE raced evenly in the second flight, swung five to six wide upper stretch, failed to threaten despite being hard ridden. CART MARTIAL lacked speed, offered little. PUSH BUTTON lacked speed, raced towards the rear throughout, failed to factor.
