NAYEER unhurried early racing in the second flight, rallied to split foes in upper stretch, quickly drew off and widened margin being ridden out for an easy score. KISSIN IN THE DARK broke alertly and angled to the rail, opened up mid turn, began to tire inside the eighth pole, was fully extended late just holding on to second place. SHELBY'S STAR trailed to mid turn, angled out for room in upper stretch, bid four wide from mid stretch, surged late just missing second place. ASKMETHEQUESTIONS well placed stalking around the turn, gave chase into the lane, lacked response besting rest. BURKINA showed good early speed stalking to top of the lane, began to tire in mid stretch, no late factor. POSH LADY settled in the second flight, roused coming six wide upper stretch, failed to respond never menacing. MANATEE DIVERS made a slight bobble at the break, trailed mid turn, offered little. CLAY BASKET pressed briefly for the early lead, retreated mid turn, gave way upper stretch finishing weary.
