Footnotes

IRON FIRE stalked a loose CHARLES through the turn cutting the margin when saving ground to upper stretch, angled off the rail as the leader drifting getting up late in the two path. CHARLES broke sharply moving well clear through the turn, coming four wide in upper stretch became fatigued drifting to the rail being run down in the closing yards. FLANKERSBERG tracked evenly through the turn saving ground to upper stretch, gave steady response from the eighth pole closing the gap in the two path. LA GUERRE slow early angled six wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. EIGHT EM UP slow early lost ground to upper stretch racing seven wide down the lane as no menace. FRAIDY in tight at the break came six wide in upper stretch playing no factor. WEATHER TRICK went evenly through the turn then wore down in the four path the final eighth. LLOYD BRAUN was always outrun. HUH away slowly stayed back throughout. BORN OF FIRE gave way on the turn.
