**Footnotes**

SLIGO KNOWS broke well stalking STAINED GLASS down the backstretch, bid three wide on the far turn, drew even mid turn, edged clear at the quarter pole, drew off from upper stretch and won easily being ridden out. STAINED GLASS hustled to the front, angled towards the inside setting a rated pace, headed by the winner leaving the far turn, battled to the quarter pole, yielded turning for home, angled out under a stiff drive giving chase, failed to threaten but dug in saving second place in a hard effort. PAWN SHOP QUEEN well placed early on, put to a drive from the quarter pole, angled towards the rail mid stretch, finished willingly just missing second place. WHAT SAY YOU forwardly placed traveling along the inside, angled out to the three path upper stretch, failed to respond to rousing, finished evenly besting rest. IT'S TIFFIN TIME broke a bit inward and was taken up briefly, settled in good tracking position running three to four wide to the half, asked from mid turn, lacked rally never threatening. HOB NOBIN settled in the second flight running at mid track, roused mid turn, failed to respond, no factor. ALBANY INDIAN trailed early, mildly improved placing in the lane but never factored. FLASHY FOOTNOTE lacked speed racing towards the rear, swung six wide top of the stretch, failed to threaten. ASHLEE'S MOM unhurried leaving the gate, asked mid turn, came four wide running between rivals in upper stretch, lacked needed response. ITSALLABOUTMENOW retreated early, offered little.
