Footnotes

DOT sent from the gate, set all the pace while a little off the inside, asked for more top of the lane, responded to increase margin under strong handling. DIAMOND HEIRLOOM stumbled at the start, quickly rushed to chase the winner throughout, raced mid track, was hard ridden on the turn, failed to menace but held the place position in a game effort. CLASSIC VISIT rated early, roused mid turn, angled into the lane, closed ground willingly. QUIZ THE MAID raced evenly along the rail entering the stretch, failed to rally despite being hard ridden. WILDABOUTAUNTY was outrun, swung widest into the lane, closed gap too late, no threat. DELIVERY CART raced evenly at mid track, lacked late kick, no factor. FASHIONABLY LITE raced up close, bid to loom three wide mid turn, was all done in upper stretch. SHORE WEAVE stumbled at the break, rushed to chase along the rail, gave way leaving the quarter pole, no factor.
