Footnotes

HANDSOME HARBOR prompted the pace wresting the lead on the turn, took charge in upper stretch drawing away under a drive in the two path. MOUNTAIN A. P. broke alert to the early lead, engaged by HANDSOME HARBOR on the turn proved no match in upper stretch staying after it while angling to the three path a clear second best. DARN REY tracked the pace through the turn, dropped off the top pair in upper stretch going evenly in the three path to hold the others. PEINADO veered in brushing at the break, was hustled from off the pace proving no menace. RUBADUB CHUB slow early was never involved finishing at mid track. VANHOOSE away slowly played no factor. ROMAS SPIRIT pressed early then weakened on the turn giving way to upper stretch. SIR DUR dropped back along the inside laboring through the stretch.
