COUNTESS CLAUDIA slow early emerged to contention at mid track in upper stretch, angling in to the four slot would clear in the closing yards. ELIZABETH'S DREAM broke alertly working to go clear on the turn, widening near the rail in upper stretch would extend late to no avail. CART MARTIAL slow early was circled out to upper stretch bidding belatedly in the six path. WINTER RIDGE pressed then chased through the turn, extended in the three path upper stretch would weaken late. SMART AND PRETTY bumped at the break was outrun through the turn, gave an even finish under a stiff drive. JITTER IN ROME stumbling at the break was rushed to pressure the pace through the turn, would give way near mid track down the stretch. GOLDEN DOVE raced evenly early, wore down from the quarter pole. REAL FANCY was always outrun. ELEFThERIA was never involved.
