LEX'S SHADOW well placed tracking the pace around the turn, came four wide upper stretch, drew even inside the furlong marker, took the lead in deep stretch and prevailed under an all out drive. STILL OWING unhurried early, angled out five wide mid stretch, surged on the winner at the wire narrowly missing in a hard effort. RUSH DELIVERY raced up close from the start, bid three wide for the lead at the quarter pole, moved clear in mid stretch, battled late when headed by top pair but was outfinished in last strides. MY DADDY'S JEWEL was hard used vying for the lead racing along the rail throughout, came up short despite being hard ridden. WILD PACIFIC WAVES trailed to the quarter pole, split foes entering the stretch, moved inside mid stretch, finished strongly improving placing but was no real threat. POOKIE'S PRINCESS lacked early foot racing mid track, came widest in the eight path upper stretch, mildly bid in mid stretch then leveled off needing more late. G T'S GOT TO DANCE raced evenly in the second flight, lacked response when roused, no factor. VINDICTIVE raced briefly in mid pack between rivals, faded from the quarter pole. BLUE DOOR was hard used holding a slim early advantage, started to drop off turning for home, finished spent.
