BATON ROUGE settled early firing on the turn blowing clear to upper stretch, was put away late. SCOOBY slow early gave a mild rally four wide to upper stretch coming on for place. JAZZ REBEL dropped back early, rallied into upper stretch finishing well in the three path. FIRST OSCAR slow early stayed back to upper stretch, gained belatedly with mild action running past tired ones. KING THOU ART away alertly chased through the turn then wore down the final eighth along the inside. DARLIN I'M READY sent clear was hustled on lead through the turn then wilted on the inside down the lane. BURNING LIGHT acting up coming out was bumped at the break, played no factor. RIGHT ON QUEUE was never involved. BRIEF NOTE chased early then gave way on the turn.
