Footnotes

PRAISEWORTHY slow early advanced from the three sixteenths pole hooking ALTA BOY an eighth out, dueled abreast in the three path extending to clear. ALTA BOY pressured the pace putting a head in front on the turn, hooked by PRAISEWORTHY in the two path upper stretch would battle to the end. SORDISA pressured the pace from between horses early then abreast ALTA BOY on the turn, weakened in upper stretch going evenly along the inside to hold the others. PUTITALLTOGETHER slow early raced four path down the stretch finishing evenly. ESSAY MONEY veered out leaving the gate, pressed early along the inside, ceded on the turn fading near the rail in upper stretch. BIG CARLOS PASS dropped back on the turn. KID KLARE was always outrun.
