Footnotes

LUCY'S SCORE stalked the pace along the inside through the turn, angled out in upper stretch rallying up from mid track. GALLOP GIRL pressed a short early lead shaking clear on the turn, digging in from the three path was hooked late ceding to outside pressure. IN D SHADOW a step slow through the turn came three path upper stretch moving past the others with even action. PROUDTOBEALEADER slow early gained some ground on the turn then weakened on the inside down the stretch. WILD FLARE away slowly was outrun through the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch passed tired ones. MISS ALUVIAL pressed early then chased on the turn, would give way empty in upper stretch. SETAS SASSY SHOES raced evenly through the turn then folded at mid track in upper stretch. IAM THE WORD was always outrun. SHAWN DEE labored throughout. IRREPLACEABLE JAZZ was never involved.
