A LITTLE GRAND broke sharply moving on a clear lead traveling inside through the turn, widened in the two then three path down the stretch holding firm the final eighth. BORN TO DISCO chased the pace through the turn, angled four path upper stretch proved no match for the winner holding as a clear second best. LEDGE'S MONARCHOS slow early angled inside gaining to upper stretch, held position along the rail. SECRET CARESS away slowly was outrun through the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch posing no menace. MYLILMONEYMAKER chased early then wavered on the turn dropping off in the three path. NEWPORT LULU raced a step slow in second flight tiring to upper stretch. FLAMING PUNCH was always outrun. THERES ALWAYS HOPE was never involved.
