GO GONE GIRL was off a step slow, rushed up along the rail to stalk, cut the corner entering the stretch, vied in a four way battle upper stretch, drew off inside the eighth pole. SARAH DOUGLAS unhurried from the gate and trailed to mid turn, swung out seven wide launching rally top of the stretch, finished strongly securing second place nearing the wire. LE BEE settled towards the rear, came five wide under a stiff drive mid stretch, loomed at the eighth pole, was edged out of second place in last jumps. KAIN'S VOW rushed a four wide move coming to the quarter pole, took over turning for home, weakened a sixteenth out and was outfinished for a minor award. THE NATIVE BLAZE settled in the second flight, angled six wide into the lane, gave chase under urging, leveled off needing more late. MIDNIGHT ABBEY raced evenly along the rail, roused from the quarter pole, failed to respond. JACKIE G trailed around the turn, slightly improved placing but never factored. ELIZABETH'S DREAM showed good early foot, dueled to mid turn running between foes, gave way top of the lane, used up. PRIZE FEVER was hard used in the early going, vied to the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch finishing spent.
