Footnotes

LUNAR PASS went evenly through the turn rallying in the three path upper stretch, surged on the inside of rivals getting up gamely at the wire. ROMAN ROULETTE tracked the pace through the turn coming seven wide in upper stretch, surged late outside of rivals just missing. SNEAKIN THE GOLD broke sharply setting the pace widening on the turn, digging in from the four path became a bit weary late ceding between horses at the wire. CITIZEN'S ARREST stalked the pace through the turn coming five wide in upper stretch, extending at mid track would hang late. BROTHER KEITH a step slow early moved up on the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch weakened the final eighth. IT'SAPOSSIBILITY chased early then wavered on the turn fading from contention into upper stretch. FOURTH TOP flashed early speed then gave way on the turn. HOTNITESINMICHIGAN was always outrun.
