**Footnotes**

BAVARIAN PRINCE rated early, rallied between foes in upper stretch, dueled in three way battle from the eighth pole, was in tight coming to the wire, just prevailed in last jump being fully extended. GOLD SPARK tracked contested pace, rallied three wide entering the stretch, dueled abreast rivals from the eighth pole, was nosed out in last jump, very game effort. CONNOISSEUR rushed from the gate, bid on the turn to vie for command, took a slight lead upper stretch and angled over to the rail, dueled in three way battle coming to the finish, was in close quarters running along the rail and steadied briefly at the wire, missed in hard effort. DA TRAVELIN MAN was outrun early, found stride upper stretch, closed fast in deep stretch. FLOATER rated early, raced along the rail to top of the stretch, angled out upper stretch, needed more late. WEST LONG BRANCH hustled to race up close briefly, chased on the turn, swung out wide top of the lane, lacked late kick. WINDSOR DICKENS raced evenly and wide on the bend, asked for more, failed to menace. IRISHAMERICANDREAM lacked speed, angled out top of the lane, never factored. FEISTY FOX sent hard, pressed while between foes to the quarter pole, was all done mid stretch. SILVER ASSET broke sharply, set a pressured pace, began to give way entering the stretch, used up.
