Footnotes

MILLION BELLS stalked the pace off the inside edging closer on the far turn, bid clear in upper stretch then extended at mid track to hold to inside pressure. POET'S EYE tracked the pace four deep to the far turn, responded to loom off MILLION BELLS at mid track in upper stretch, taken to the inside near the eighth pole gave all in the closing yards. MUST BE GOLD unhurried early gained contention cutting the corner to upper stretch, pressing from the inside would prove no match. LLAMARADA away slowly was swung seven wide in upper stretch gaining position late. YAWM ESTOORA sent clear set a moderate pace through the far turn, ceded to MILLION BELLS in upper stretch dropping back soon after, bled. BLACK MINK away slowly had a modest response to upper stretch, failed to menace from mid track. TIP ALONG rated early would flatten into upper stretch. MISS BODINE crowded at the break would lose ground failing to mount a bid. MORNING PRAYERS stopped after a half mile, was eased to the wire.
