DURAND PARK broke sharply, set a clear pace to upper stretch, widened driving in the three path. WISE MR. BEAN tracked early, rallied inside on the turn, angled four wide upper stretch chasing late saving place. LAGOON tracked evenly through the turn, bid on the rail down the stretch, held position. WYNN BY GEORGE slow early, varied little to upper stretch, had modest late response. J'S REDBUD SPIRIT chased the pace through the turn then weakened at mid track in upper stretch. SIX MILLER'S raced a step slow coming four wide upper stretch, proved no menace. SPURIOUS was never involved. STAN'S GOT TALENT gave way on the turn. SOUTHERN STAR was always outrun. ANOTHER LOVE labored throughout.
