SPEAK OF KINGS broke sharply to grab the early lead, moved well on the pace racing off the inside, challenged from the outside by MORE SMOKE approaching the 1/4 pole, shook off rival digging in to hold firm late. MORE SMOKE hustled out to follow SPEAK OF KINGS into the turn, tried rival from the outside nearing the 1/4 pole, had bid rebuffed entering the lane, continued to chase under a drive while salvaging place. TIM'S LAST CHANCE showed good early speed along the rail, dropped off the leaders while continuing to save ground on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch to bid near the 1/8 pole, couldn't sustain the inside bid hanging late. NESTASKO bobbled at the break, raced evenly off the pace set down near mid track stretch, proved no menace outbidding others. CAST NO SHADOW sent up early, pursued to the turn, wavered there fading back, tried to recover in upper stretch, had little left in drive. FORT CHESTNUT stumbled badly leaving the gate, had little chance after. TIGER ON TOUR always a step slow, was empty at the 1/4 pole. FENCE CAT rushed out with early speed, wilted soon after entering the turn.
