**Footnotes**

PIERSIXER was unhurried and raced wide down the backside, gained momentum top of the lane, split foes mid stretchy, angled wider to rally, surged in last jumps to get up on the wire under good handling. SET TO SPARKLE well placed, tracked a heated speed, duel, bid four wide top of the lane, took a slight lead mid stretch, appeared to be the winner inside the sixteenth pole, but got nailed on the tire, game effort. THIS ONE FOR ABBEY raced evenly early on, angled to split foes mid stretch, moved back towards the inside late, closed willingly, game try. SEA OF PROMISES was bumped at the break, hustled to track, angled to the rail at the quarter pole, came through narrow opening upper stretch, vied under an all out drive to deep stretch, was outfinished late. MISS BONN BONN broke out leaving the gate, lacked speed, roused and was seven wide into the lane, closed the gap willingly too late. FAVORITE GIRL raced evenly in second flight, moved to the rail upper stretch, needed more at the finish despite being hard ridden. PROUD TEARS raced off a heated speed, duel, angled four wide and between foes top of the lane, vied to mid stretch, weakened from there. TIGRESS BYTHETAIL sent hard, duelled through a rapid pace, gave way at the eighth pole, used. FINANCIAL RISK rushed to duel through a quick opening half, had nothing left in upper stretch, gave way.
